The message or meaning of Hunters in the Snow sometimes called The return of the Hunters. The painting offers a bird's eye view of a world locked in winter that is nevertheless teeming with life,. Perspective is very important in Hunter's in the Snow. A sense of space and distance is created by the positioning and



size of the trees and the size, colour and detail in buildings etc in the fore, mid and background.
