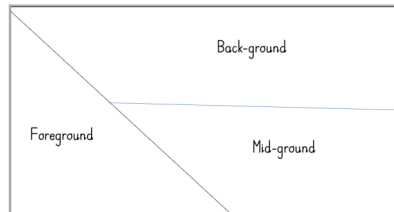
Artist Biography Pieter Bruegel the Elder 1525– 1569
 Born in Breda, now the Netherlands. He deliberately rejected the Italian style of painting and focused on painting ordinary people in their daily lives. One of the most renown painters of his time..

The message or meaning of Hunters in the Snow sometimes called The return of the Hunters. The painting offers a bird's eye view of a world locked in winter that is nevertheless teeming with life.. Perspective is very important in Hunter's in the Snow. A sense of space and distance is created by the positioning and size of the trees and the size, colour and detail in buildings etc in the fore, mid and background.
