Music Words

Dynamics (Volume)
How loud or quiet a piece of music is.

Tempo (Speed)
How fast or slow a piece of music is.

Beat
The main rhythmic pattern in a piece of music.

Pitch
Whether notes are high or low.

Rhythm
The pattern of sounds (notes or words) in music.

Pulse
The beat in a piece of music.

pulse	The steady beat of the music.
beat	A pattern in music
rhythm	How high or low the note is.
tempo	How fast or slow a piece of music is
timbre	Something which makes voices or instruments different
